## Example of How to Read the Line up/Roll Sheet

Each volunteer has different needs. The actual Line up/Roll Sheet you receive might have subtle differences than what is projected here.

Students who have "Audience" before their dance are only in Act II and might be taken out into the audience to watch - Act I if there is room in the audience. You will be notified if this is possible. Students will need to return to the Dressing Room just before the Intermission. Tells Dressing Room A Volunteer what table the student is sitting at. Tells Runners what side this student exits to, and what tables the student is sitting at. Check to make sure your students have the correct color of costume, tights, shoes and hair.
