

Example of How to Read the Line up/Roll Sheet

Each volunteer has different needs. The actual Line up/Roll Sheet you receive might have subtle differences than what is projected here.

Students who have "Audience" before their dance are only in Act II and might be taken out into the audience to watch Act I if there is room in the audience. You will be notified if this is possible. Students will need to return to the Dressing Room just before the Intermission.

Tells Dressing Room A Volunteer what table the student is sitting at.

Tells Runners what side this student exits to, and what dressing room to take this student to when their number is done.

Check to make sure your students have the correct color of costume, tights, shoes and hair.

Tells Dressing Room A what tables the volunteers are covering.

A "#" with "First" after it means that this is the first number that this student is in.

Means this student is in a previous number and will not be part of this class when the show starts. They will join the class later.

Tells what dressing room a student will be found in. A "Q" means this student has a quick change from their previous # and will be in the quick change room. An "S" means that the student is already up on the stage. "ABCD" denote Dressing Rooms.

This tells the Runners that this student enters on Stage Right on the Blue Line. She is 2nd in Line and will end up on Letter C. There are 4 lines: Blue, Red, Green, and Purple each with an alphabet.

This informs that this student has a rented costume that must be collected from the student and returned to the Studio.

This is the next dance the student is in. Help them into their next costume and if they are in Dressing Room A, help them find their new table.

The Items above tell you what the student has to get into for their next number. Please get them ready for this next number unless you are specifically told not to.
